The question was brought up about the amount of reimbursement dollars the club can charge the state for the type of equipment we use. Roy Lawrenz will check into in to the extra \$5.00 per hour for the groomer.

Andy Baker brought up a discussion on the clubs new signs, which will be installed next June. The conclusion was the club started in 1970 and he is to get samples of colors and wording and etc. and present it to the members at the April meeting to make a choice.

Gene Duffy gave a report on the use of ATV's for brushing and signing of trails on Public Land. Permits are needed. They are obtained from the County Parks Department.

Tom Stadler informed members of the new signs he will be ordering for improved ways to sign our trails to identify corners.

Hubert Wiedemeier is working on re-routing a portion on the Klondike trail which will make it a safer trail.

A petition, to keep ATV's from using snowmobile trails was presented and available for members to sign.

On Saturday June 9<sup>th</sup> the club will have a picnic, installing new sign and the election of officers and directors, Eva Gmand will chair this event. The President asked Eva to check into the cost of purchasing a large canopy to be used for the club functions.

A discussion was held about, if Mark Kuchta purchases a grader for use on the trails if the club would sign a contract and handle it like the grooming contract. Appointed members are checking into this.
