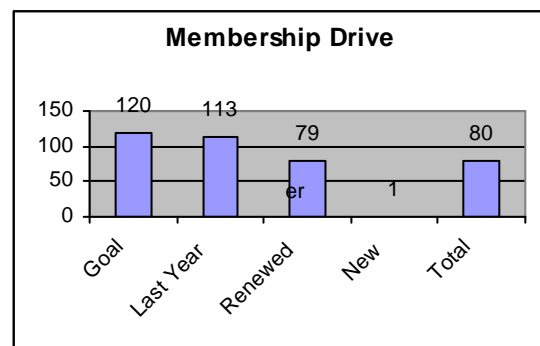

### **NOVEMBER 10, 2007 MINUTES**

Meeting was called to order by President Roy Lawrenz at 9:05A.M.at Wescott Lake Bar. Sixteen members are present.

### **FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS**

#### **Secretary's Report**

A motion to accept the Secretary's report in the minutes was made by Gerry Frey and seconded by Tony Gmand. Motion approved.

### **SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS**

#### **Treasurer's Report**

A motion to accept the Treasurer's report as given was made by Tom Stadler and seconded by Mike Lambert. Motion approved. All state funding has been received to date from last season.

### **THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS**

#### **Old Business**

#### **DINNER RIDE**

The dinner ride is set for February 9, 2008 at Walkers Bay Supper Club. Discussion was made as to whether we would be inviting the landowners and their guests to the dinner. The members agreed that this tradition would continue. We should also try to get some way to identify the landowners by way of name badges or a ribbon at the dinner so they can get special recognition.

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

Total membership is at 77 renewals and one new member. 42 members have renewed in October.

Trail bosses are working on getting all the slips signed and turned in. No major problems noted.

#### **MAP AD SPONSORS**

Kathy Lawrenz has finished with her sponsors. No report from Joyce Sukowski as to the status of her sponsors. Falls Action Sports on Hwy 141 is selling the business but currently still open.

#### **AWSC MEETING**

Environmental assessment in Townsend was discussed and the need to reroute trails due to the tornado damage. 20,000 maps have been printed and complete and will remain the same size as last year.

#### **ATV PERMITS**

Temporary ATV permits were received by the club from Oconto County for members to carry when they are brushing or working on the trails on county land. There are extra copies and will be kept in the clubhouse along with a copy of the special use permit for the season.

#### **CHAIN SAW**

Roy presented the members with literature and costs of a 16 inch Stihl chain saw with case to be kept in the groomer. Tom Stadler made a motion to purchase the model as agreed upon for \$249.95 plus \$45.00 for the case. Andy Baker seconded the motion. Motion passed.

#### **WAYSIDES ON THE TRAIL SYSTEM**

### **WELCOME SIGNS AND BRIDGES**

On November 3<sup>rd</sup> the remaining three welcome signs were put in place on our trail system and a 12 foot by 18 foot bridge was constructed and put in the sanitary district by Kelly Lake. The club rented a lift and worked from 8 am until 6 pm. We would like to thank our volunteers, Andy Baker, Ryan Baker, Tom Stadler, Mike Lambert, Tom Yingling, Roy Lawrenz and Bill Weslow for all your hard work.

### **TRAIL REPORTS**

**GERRY FREY** – A temporary trail will be marked by the side of the road until January 6<sup>th</sup> past Thompson's to bypass Jocco Lake.

**TOM STADLER** – Between Lee and Round Lake an alternate route will have to be put in past the new house to accommodate approximately 30 feet of the landowners' driveway. Two areas on the pipeline will need fill or grading. One area on the north end and a bigger area on the south end. Mark Kuchta will be looking the areas over. An area behind Lee Lake Tavern could be graded also.

**BERT WIEDEMIER** – Needs to check with one landowner west of Klondike to see if a trail needs to be rerouted due to a new building that was suppose to be in.

**ANDY BAKER**- Trails are finished. One landowner might reroute part of trail thru his

land near Suring. Motion made by Jerry Frey and seconded by Bert Wiedemeier to authorize funds to landowner Suring for crop damage.

**GENE DUFFY** – No status report.

### **TRAIL WORK**

Volunteers needed to brush areas between 201 and Cooley Lake, a heavy wooden snow fence approximately 100 feet long needs to be put up where the bridge was built last week in the sanitary district and brushing is needed by the Round Lake area. Plenty of volunteers were obtained from the meeting.

### **SIGNS**

Tom Stadler has ordered the new right and left arrow signs and some will they will have to be put on stakes after they come in.

### **WEBSITE**

Mike Lambert informed us that our website has received 5000 unique hits since its inception. He will be writing an article and submitting it with pictures to the WSN magazine and local newspapers regarding our signs that were hung and bridges that were built.

Motion was made by Gerry Frey to adjourn and seconded by Tom Stadler. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 10:10 A.M.
