Cooks Corner

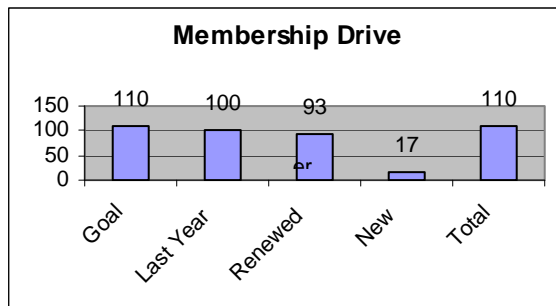
