April 8, 2006 Minutes

Meeting was called to order by President Roy Lawrenz at 9:10 a.m. at the storage shed.

First Order of Business:

Secretary's Report

A motion was made by Jerry Frey and seconded by Tom Yingling to accept the report as mailed. Motion approved.

Second Order of Business:

Treasure's Report

A report given by Roy Lawrenz and he stated the club received a tax form to be filed with the IRS. A motion was made by Tom Stadler to hire an accountant to look into this matter and approve the treasures report, seconded by Tom Yingling. Motion approved.

Third Order of Business:

Old Business

The deer hunting T-Zone issue regarding some of our trails seems to have resolved it self.

Trails:

A total of 458 hours of grooming will be submitted for state funding. The hours submitted puts us well into supplemental funding.

Trails this year where excellent and we had a lot of favorable input from snowmobiler's outside our club. A big thank you goes out to our groomer drivers.

Next year there will be some bridge work necessary on the trail to White Potato.

Fifth Order of Business:

New Business

Tom Statler was approached with a buyer for our old drag. Jerry Frey made a motion for Tom Stadler to approach Black Bear Golf Course regarding their status of purchasing our drag. It is necessary for us to get this drag sold as storage is an issue. Motion seconded by Tom Yingling. Motion approved.

Discussion took place regarding securing permission for use of Pipe Line road for next year, from the Bagley Town Board, in the early season when the pipeline trail is soft in due to the springs in that area. We will discuss further at our October meeting.

Andy Baker stated that while on vacation he saw a sign (club info.) over a trail. It was lighted and mounted on telephone posts. It was suggested that we seek permission to place a sign in the Kelly Lake Area. There is a possibility for AWSC state funding for this. We will review this proposal at the October meeting.

In place of summer picnic a September Kick Off Meeting was discussed. Black Bear will be contacted to see if we will be able to hold it there on September 16, for a luncheon meeting.

Motion to adjourn was made by Don Whittman, seconded by Jerry Frey. Motion approved.
