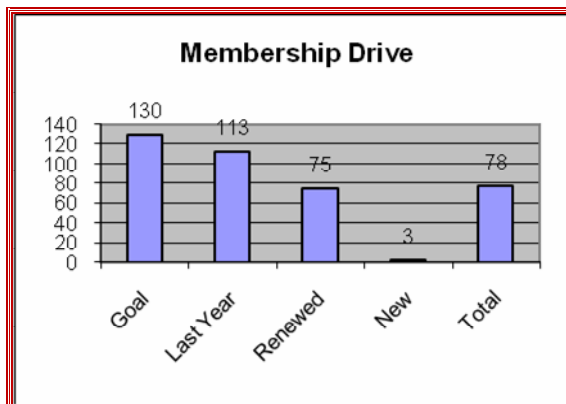

OCTOBER 11, 2008 MINUTES

Meeting was called to order by Roy Lawrenz, President at 9:20 A.M. at Wescott Lake Tavern. Twelve members were present.

FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS

Secretary's Report

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

OLD BUSINESS

WHITE POTATO LAKE TRAIL BOSS

Don Wittmann has agreed to phone landowners this year for permission to cross land their land on our trail system in the White Potato Lake area. We also have a volunteer to mark the trail on the Northern half of the trail from Walkers Bay to the West and we may possibly have found another volunteer to mark the Southern half of the trail.

LEE LAKE TRAIL REROUTE

The new trail is partially opened from Round Lake to Lee Lake Tavern. Landowners' permission has been

obtained. Some areas of the trail are 12 feet wide. A big thank you to Roy and Jonathan Lawrenz, Andy and Ryan Baker, Tom Yingling, Tom Stadler and Ron Tank for making this trail possible.

GROOMER DRAG

Dale will be transporting the groomer drag to the buyers in Minnesota. Our old drag has been picked up from the Suring Golf Course and is now at the storage shed at Lee Lake. Tom Stadler will need to do a little repair work on it before we put it up for sale.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS TRAILS

Tom Stadler spoke with Don from the ATV club who told him that the Pipeline will be graded after November 1st by the ATV club. Trail boss Andy Baker will monitor the situation.

The ATV club will be tearing out and rebuilding the long bridge on our trail system that we ride along side of as we leave Butler Springs Road and head west. It should be complete by December 1st. The decking off the old bridge will be used to re-deck another bridge on our trail system by the ATV club. Our club will put in another post on that bridge to reinforce the corner that was hit last season.

There is a section of trail in the Rost Lake area on County land that we will be re-routing due to a steep hill for the groomer. Tom Stadler and Tom Yingling will work on that project with the new brush cutter.

ATV OR UTV

MARINETTE COUNTY FUNDING

Dale Behnke reported that there will be no new funding for trails in Marinette County. Our funding for our 5-6 miles in Marinette County was again turned down this year.

CHAINSAW
